

Funky Dozen Channel Assignment

The following is a list of inputs and the I/O (mics, D.I. etc.) we normally use for those inputs. When we do not use our own sound system, we utilize a splitter snake so we can get signal into our Mackie DL32R for In-Ear Monitoring. The snake splits the signal before going into our board so that the signal is routed to the host system unaltered. Normally, no on-stage monitors or fills are used.
